

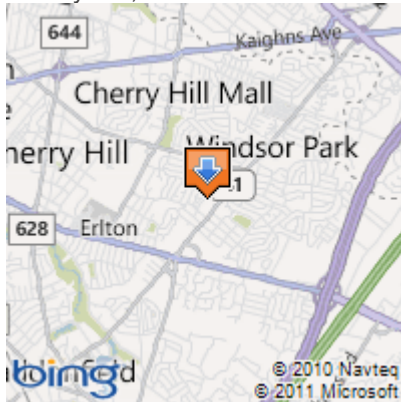

The Cherry Hill School District is one of only three in the state to receive generous funding from [The Geraldine R. Dodge Foundation](#) to participate in a long term and comprehensive project designed to develop whole school capacity to develop our youth to be participants, innovators and leaders for a sustainable future.

Cherry Hill was chosen because of the Township's role as a [statewide leader](#), through its partnership with the non-profit, [Sustainable Cherry Hill](#) and its recent certification at the Silver Level of the [Sustainable Jersey](#) program. This project will require deep collaboration between the schools, township and community in Cherry Hill.

As a kick off to this exciting project, we are planning a series of workshops and hope to engage a wide variety of community members. We are seeking residents, community/business leaders, teens and more as we build a shared understanding of a sustainable future.

An evening "Community Consensus Building" workshop (January 5, 7 -9pm): In this workshop, we will create a shared understanding of sustainability and what it means to educate for it among the members of community in order to maximize Cherry Hill's collective ability to shift toward sustainability together over time. We anticipate participation by our newly minted Cherry Hill Township Mayor Cahn and staff, Superintendent Dr. Maureen Reusche and staff, members of Cherry Hill Town Council and BOE, Art Campbell from the Cherry Hill Chamber of Commerce, passionate community members and more! A two day "Intro to Sustainability" workshop (January 5-6, 8:30am to 3:30pm): In this workshop, we will create a learning community that engages participants in activities that combine systems thinking, sustainable economics, and the science of sustainability. This workshop is designed to increase participants' awareness, knowledge, and a shared understanding of sustainability and the core concepts, knowledge, skills and attitudes that characterize education for sustainability. In addition to teachers and administrators from the three middle schools, there will be some community members, some folks from neighboring towns and hopefully some kids too!
