POLICY 3515.2

**STAFF USE OF WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY, CELLULAR TELEPHONES AND
ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

The Cherry Hill Board of Education permits the possession of wireless technology and cellular telephones on school property. The Board of Education encourages the use of technology in the classroom as an educational tool and to promote student achievement. However, cell phones, I-Pods, or other similar electronic devices containing a wireless card or aircard, must be silenced or disabled and may not be used for personal purposes while staff members are assigned to teach or supervise students.

Accordingly, this policy applies only to the personal use of electronic devices by staff on school grounds during student contact times. This policy shall not be interpreted to regulate the use of technology for educational purposes in an academic setting.

For good cause, the Superintendent of Schools or designee may prohibit the use of such devices within a particular school. The Board of Education takes no responsibility for the loss or theft of such devices. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary actions.
