POLICY 5142.2

STUDENT PHOTO IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Board of Education is charged with providing for the protection and welfare of all students enrolled in its schools while they are on Board of Education property or engaged in Board of Education sponsored activities. To fulfill this responsibility, including the administration of established controls, it is necessary that duly authorized Board of Education employees be able to identify all students and to distinguish them from other people for whom the Board of Education is not responsible.

To this end, the Superintendent of Schools shall develop and implement a student identification system for all students in grades six through twelve.

Each student shall be expected to have his/her identification card in his/her possession at all times when he/she is on Board of Education property, including transportation vehicles, or when participating in a Board of Education sponsored activity. If the nature of an athletic or other activity makes personal possession impossible, a student shall have his/her identification card as near at hand as may be feasible.

A student shall be expected to produce his/her identification card upon the request of a Board of Education employee in the exercise of that employee's assigned duty.
