POLICY 6142.13

COMPUTER APPLICATIONS and OTHER RELATED DEVELOPMENT

With the increased emphasis on technology in our society and the commitment by the Cherry Hill Board of Education to implement technology literacy skills for students and staff, the Cherry Hill Board of education encourages the development of computer applications, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites by students and staff for instructional and administrative purposes.

STUDENTS

Computer applications, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites developed by students through projects assigned in the classroom or through special arrangement and with the assistance of the teacher are the property of the student. The Board of Education, however, reserves the right to make use of the computer applications, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites, without charge and within the Cherry Hill Public Schools if the program was developed with teacher assistance and with school equipment.

The Board of Education waives any other rights to computer applications, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites.

STAFF

The Board of Education waives the rights to computer applications, curriculum mapping, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites developed through the initiative of teachers utilizing school equipment under the condition that the Board reserves the right to use the computer applications, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites and any modifications, improvements and supplements or additions thereto, without charge, within the school system. In this circumstance, use of school equipment is only authorized in the development of computer applications, curriculum mapping, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites for instructional or administrative use within the Cherry Hill Public Schools.

If the computer applications, curriculum mapping, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites are directed by the Board of Education while providing a stipend, released time, or through funds received from Board of Education approved grants, then the computer applications, curriculum mapping, online portfolios, webquests, online learning activities, and websites become the property of the Cherry Hill Board of Education.
