POLICY 6142.1

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND ACCESS

The Cherry Hill Board of Education believes that an effective instructional program requires access to a wide variety of information resources; the facilitation of resource sharing; the promotion of innovative instructional practices, strategies, and activities; improved communication; and the preparation of students for the challenges of the future.

1. Students having access to Board of Education electronic communication resources shall be required to execute an acceptable use agreement.
2. All rules of student behavior shall apply to the use of district computing services and electronic equipment.
3. Websites shall exist at the school building only with the explicit permission of the building principal or designee.
4. Personal information about students, including photographs with associated names, addresses; telephone numbers, etc. shall not be published on any district approved web site.
5. If student work and/or photographs are to be published, then parental permission to do so shall be obtained in advance of publication on the web site. An exception to this paragraph will be made for candid photographs.
